

Sub: Eligibility for allocation of short supplies/lifting for Rail Borne IPP's & Non-Power Sector Rail borne consumers under FSA

Dear Sir,

It is to inform that MCL has brought out in the notice of CIL that when a rake is endorsed for FSA Consumers, the quantity is taken as 3894 tonnes for becoming eligible for a rake supply irrespective of the unloading facility at the consumer's end i.e. Tippler (BOXN) or Hopper (BOBR) or both, and this is also irrespective of what type of wagon Railways supplies, though as per railway rules for a BOBR rake only 3717 tonnes makes entitlement for 1 rake. This practise is by and large followed in all the Coal Companies because of the technical issues in FOIS as well as SAP system. This leads to less loading of coal against the entitlement of the rail borne consumers and road borne consumers get an edge because they get the Delivery order (DO) for full entitlement.

The less loading in rake supply is attributed to the following reasons:

- Supply of reject wagons which could not be loaded
- Less quantity of coal loaded onto wagons against the PCC
- Supply of BOBRN wagons even if the sanction is on BOXN/BOBRN basis

The matter has been examined at CIL and the competent Authority has approved (a copy of the approved e-office note is enclosed) regarding eligibility of FSA consumers to get coal as per FSA and actual supplies will depend on other issues like coal availability, coal allocation in the subgroup etc.

The Coal Companies are requested for immediate implementation of the system explained in the approved enclosed e-office note dated 24.01.2023 which has been approved on 25.01.2023.
